Frances Bardsley Academy is a non-denominational girl's school located in the heart of the London Borough of Havering, educating 1340 girls from the age of 11 through to 18 years.

The school educates boys and girls from the ages of 11-16 and has capacity for 50 students.

Safeguarding training is in place for all staff and leaders ensure that staff are kept up to date through weekly updates. Staff understand how to follow up any concerns and leaders work effectively with the local authority and other agencies to support pupils.
